The LINKS project is an Erasmus+ project that was launched on March of 2022 and serves two purposes by directly and actively assisting youth workers in the development and enhancement of their digital sovereignty and security skills and competencies.

1. Youth workers will increase and broaden their expertise on a personal level.

2. NGOs and other groups funded by these organizations will be well-protected and learn how to fight against abuse and/or cyber-attacks on a societal level.

1. LINKS Digital Sovereignty Competences Framework

The Framework defines the key components of competences needed by youth workers to effectively integrate digital sovereignty and security protocols into their localized contexts.

2. LINKS online platform and training material on Digital Sovereignty Competences

The training material will provide youth workers with a package of digital learning resources designed based on the concept of micro-learning: short and coherent learning nuggets delivered in multimedia formats aiming to promote blended learning methodologies.
